The glories of the Italian Baroque spring to life in the Parliament Choir's autumn concert, including all of Vivaldi's Four Seasons concerti.

These effervescent works frame choral pieces such as Francesco Durante's sparkling Magnificat, for many years attributed to his student Pergolesi, and Vivaldi's own Gloria, which is so secure a part of the core repertoire that it is hard to believe that it was rarely heard even less than a hundred years ago. The premiere of a new work by Nicholas O'Neill, the Parliament Choir's Composer-in-Residence is the modern interloper, setting Keats' poem The Human Seasons, and taking Vivaldi's concerti as its inspiration.
